

Assembling Your Holly Jolly Treat Bags

- 1. Fill the treat bags with M&M's or other small candies.
- 2. Fold the top down and tape the edge to seal it.
- 3. Fold the corners under (see photo) and tape the treat bag to the inside of the treat holder (see photo).



- 4. Fold the top flap over the candies and staple in the center of the decorated flap.
- 5. Peel the backing off the dimensional on the back of the Holly Jolly cutout and stick it to the flap with the top of the cutout near the top of the flap (refer to picture above.)
- 6. One 12.60 oz. bag of M&M's should fill eight treat bags with the suggested serving size of ¼ cup.
- 7. If desired, write a greeting on the back of the treat holder, along with the recipient's name.
